Croplan 115 RR	2,591 #/ac
Croplan 125 RR	2,742 #/ac
Dekalb 4615 RR	2,822 #/ac
Dekalb 4410 RR	3,178 #/ac
Falstaff	2,969 #/ac
Amanda (U of I)	3,316 #/ac

The field averaged 2,816.6 pounds per acre.

Varieties were planted on August 18th and August 20th in 2011.

Fertilizer at planting time, 50#N + 5#S

Aqua, 31.88 gal Thio, 1.75 gal

Top dressed with SOLN 32 @ 17 Gallons per acre = 60 #N

Total N = 110#

April 29, 2012: Sprayed Roundup Ready varieties with Roundup @ 22 oz/acre.

Flagstaff and Amanda were sprayed with Poast- 20 oz/acre plus 9-0-0-10 at 1 gallon rate.
