<b>Dekalb 4410 RR</b>	<b>3,178 #/ac</b>
<b>Falstaff</b>	<b>2,969 #/ac</b>
<b>Amanda (U of I)</b>	<b>3,316 #/ac</b>

**The field averaged 2,816.6 pounds per acre.**

**Varieties were planted on August 18<sup>th</sup> and August 20<sup>th</sup> in 2011.**

**Fertilizer at planting time, 50#N + 5#S**

**Aqua, 31.88 gal**

**Thio, 1.75 gal**

**Top dressed with SOLN 32 @ 17 Gallons per acre = 60 #N**

**Total N = 110#**

**April 29, 2012: Sprayed Roundup Ready varieties with Roundup @ 22 oz/acre.**

**Flagstaff and Amanda were sprayed with Poast- 20 oz/acre plus 9-0-0-10 at 1 gallon rate.**
