Farm Credit Distributes more than \$12 Million to Arkansas Members

The Farm Credit Services associations of Arkansas have distributed more than **\$12 million** in patronage refunds to their member-customers this spring.

Patronage refunds to Farm Credit Services customers across Arkansas now total more than \$59 million since 1997.

As a federally-chartered cooperative, the Farm Credit mission is to provide credit and associated services to agricultural producers and rural home owners as a highly competitive and locally controlled lender. Returning a portion of the cooperative's earnings to members in the form of Patronage Refunds is evidence that the Farm Credit associations in Arkansas are achieving this goal.

Statewide, Farm Credit serves more than 8,600 member-customers with more than \$1.8 billion in outstanding loans and 37 branch office locations across Arkansas.

In Arkansas, Farm Credit is represented by four independent associations and all are members of the larger Farm Credit System. Farm Credit Services of Western Arkansas, serves western counties, AgHeritage FCS serves central Arkansas, Farm Credit MidSouth serves eastern Arkansas, and Delta, ACA, with AgHeritage FCS serves the far southeastern section of the state.
