



Updated Schedule of Rates – Fall Harvest 2009

SCALE TICKETS

Please make sure your ticket is marked properly for the following: (1) landlord, (2) tenant, (3) commodity, (4) how you want your grain applied -- contract, price later, stored, or sold. All grains will be allowed one week for a final decision. Charges will not be assessed until Friday of each week.

STORAGE RATES

Corn: 19 cent minimum to Dec. 31, 2009, then (3 cents/month) pro-rated daily to Aug. 31, 2010.

Soybeans: 21 cent minimum to Dec. 31, 2009, then (3 cents/month) pro-rated daily to Aug. 31, 2010.

PRICE LATER SERVICE CHARGES

Corn: 17 cent minimum to Jan. 31, 2010, then (3 cents/month) pro-rated daily to Aug. 31, 2010.

Soybeans: 19 cent minimum to Jan. 31, 2010, then (3 cents/month) pro-rated daily to Aug. 31, 2010.

CORN OR SOYBEANS CARRIED OVER TO THE NEXT YEAR

15 cent rollover charge plus the new minimum on September 1, 2009, on grain left in open storage. Grain moved to DP or remaining on DP at September 1, 2009, is not subject to the 15 cent rollover charge, only the new minimum.

MOISTURE

Corn Sold

Charged drying and shrunk to 15%

*Drying deducted from check

Corn Stored (Open Storage & Price Later)

Charged drying to 15%

Drying invoiced in Nov. 2009, due date Jan. 2010

Shrunk to 14.5% @ 1.4% per point of moisture

Soybeans

1.25% shrink for each ½ point of moisture

Loads averaged by the day, by the job up to 15%

Loads 15.1% or higher will shrink @ rate of 2% per ½ point of moisture to 15%.

OTHER DISCOUNTS

Corn

Foreign material: 3.0% allowed – 1 cent each point 3.0 to 5.0%.

- Foreign material over 5% is subject to rejection or processor discounts

Damage: 5.0% allowed – 1 cent for each 1 point 5.0 to 7.0%.

- Damage over 7% is subject to rejection or processor discounts

Test weight: 54 lb. allowed – 1 cent each lb. to 52.0 lb.

Soybeans

Foreign material: 1.0% allowed – above 1% is a direct weight deduction.

Damage: 2.0% allowed - 4 cents each 1 point above 2%.

Test Weight: 54.0 lb. allowed – 1 cent each lb. below 54.0 lb.
